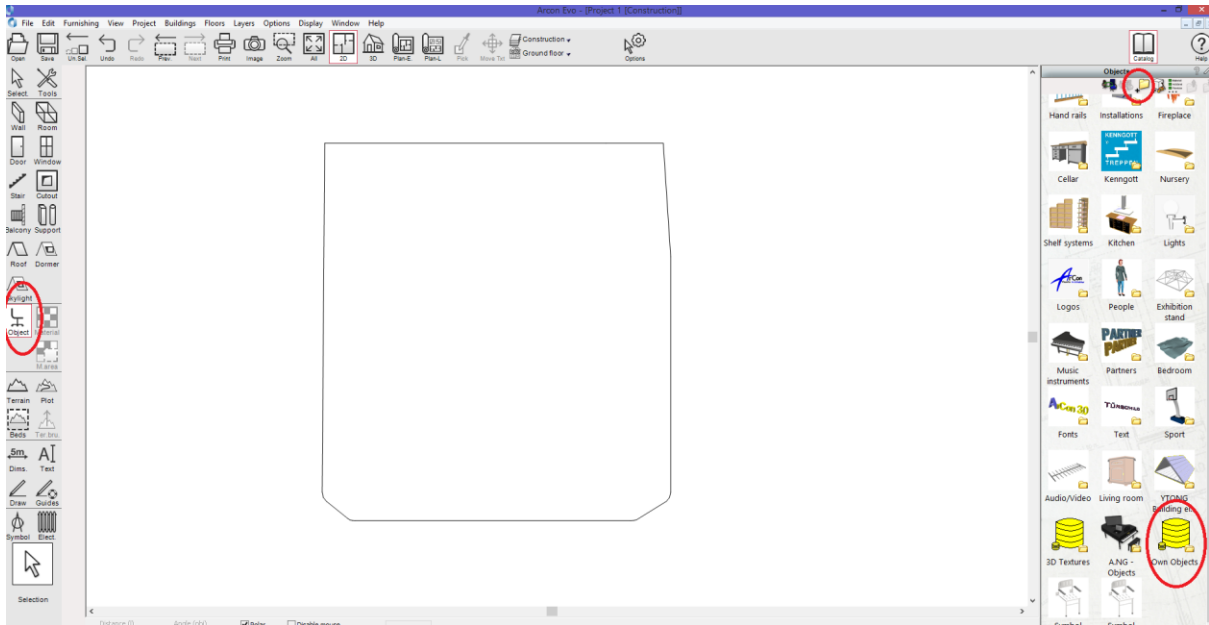
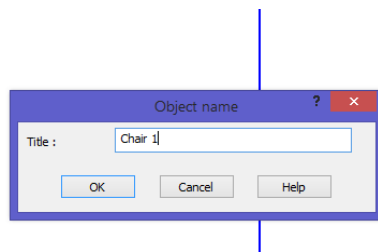


Changing 3D Object Symbol (imported and existing objects)

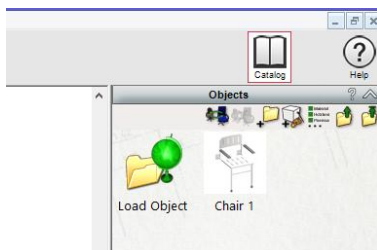
- 1) 'Load Object' through the 'Furnishing' menu
- 2) On import, open 'Objects' folder and create a 'New folder' e.g. below



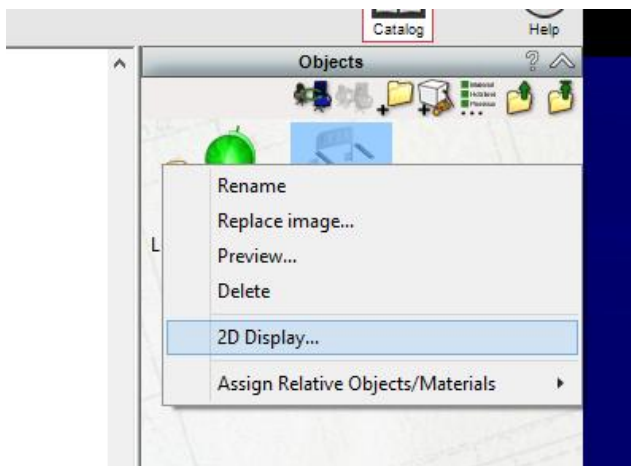
- 3) Open folder, select object and drag it in to folder in objects catalog
- 4) Following dialog will appear



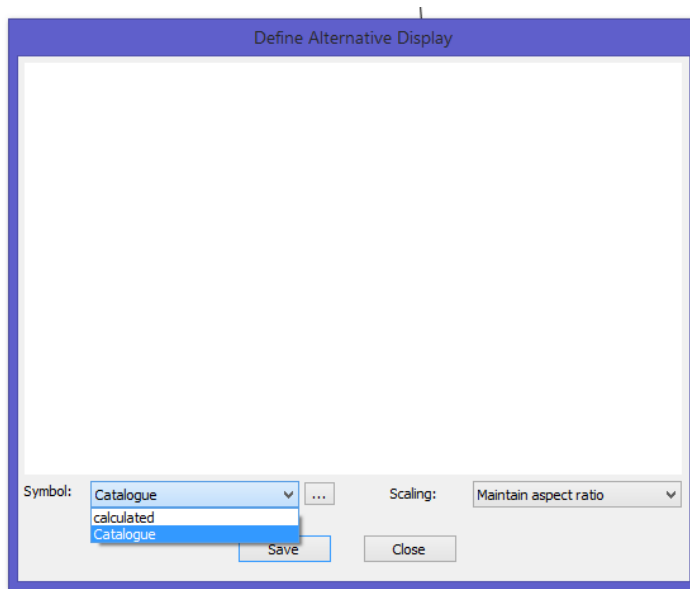
- 5) Name object. The object will appear in folder (you need to close current folder in catalog and reopen it for it to show)



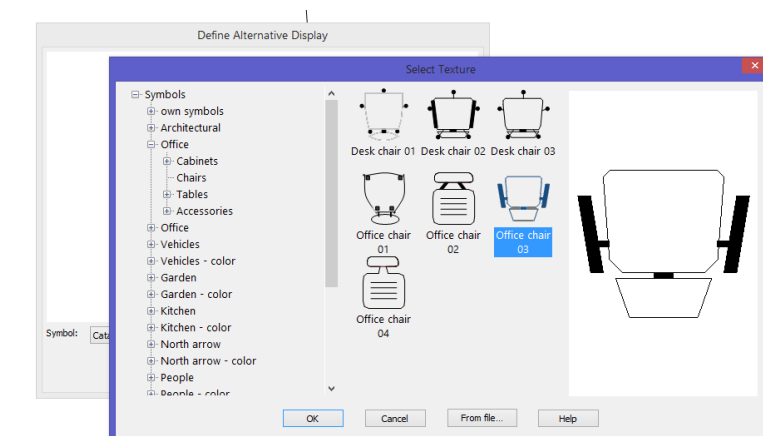
6) Right-click object and select 2D Display

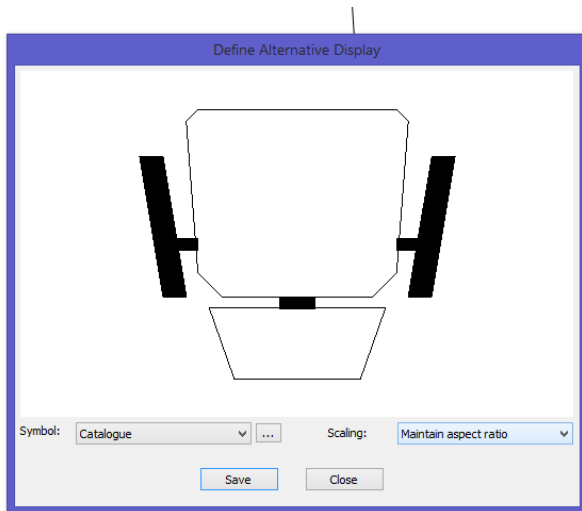


7) In dialog below select 'catalogue'



8) You can choose symbols from software library and apply it to object eg below





9) Press Save. You can then drop this on to sheet

10) If you update the object symbol in catalog then any that you have already inserted in drawing will automatically update.

Note: The object has to follow the same direction of symbol otherwise when you place object, the object might be facing one way and the symbol facing the other.

To do this, before you add object to catalog, choose your symbol e.g. sofa from library to check its orientation. If it is facing downwards e.g. below then rotate object in plan so that it is facing in same direction then add object to catalog and continue step 4)
